There is no right or wrong way to edit and create images with Photoshop Elements. Lets have a look at some of the best things you can do with Photoshop Elements. 1. Enhance your Images You can enhance an image to make it a little more appealing, improve its overall quality, increase its contrast, add a creative touch to it, or make it stand out. You can also combine the same techniques on multiple images to produce a collection of

different images. This will ensure you will have a variety of images that you can use for different purposes. There are many things that you can do with Photoshop Elements. They include:

- Remove Backgrounds** – Removing background takes time, but it can result in a cleaner, simpler image. Start by applying the Image Adjustment Brush (found on the Brush and Gradient tool) and fill the area with a layer, then go to **Select > Inverse**. This will give you the option to remove unwanted portions of an image.
- Clone Content** – You can use the Clone Content option in Photoshop Elements to copy and paste bits of an image. This is helpful because you can crop the area you want, then copy and paste the rest.
- Brighten Up Dark Images** – Use the levels options to increase the brightness of an image. You can increase it to 500 percent, reducing darkness to lighten up. You can also adjust contrast and the Shadows and Highlights sliders.
- Change Brightness** – If you want to change the overall tone of an image, you can reduce the tonal range of it. This will reduce shadow and highlight details, which gives the image a softer, more pastel appearance.
- Elements Brushes** – Photoshop Elements has different filters and brushes to help you edit your images. The Brush filter is used to create fine

details and the Gradient filter can be used to add color and shape to an image. Remove Blur – You can use the blur tool to reduce the blur in an image. Experiment with how you apply the brush stroke until you get the desired look and feel. Invert Colors – You can invert colors by simply going to the Transparency panel and selecting Invert. You can then select which color parts should be invert, such as the grass and sky. Smooth Out – By using the Smooth filter, you can create a more silky-looking texture. It is ideal for making smoother transitions between colors and shapes. Sharpen
