the world health organization's (who) global health risks report for 2016 states, climate change will affect human health at all levels of the health pyramid, from the physical environment, to the built environment, to the social environment. climate change will affect human health through direct and indirect ways: physical, psychological, and social. health effects will include infectious disease outbreaks, health impacts from extreme weather events, deaths and injuries, and malnutrition. climate change will increase risks of chronic and infectious diseases, such as non-communicable diseases, mental health conditions, and injuries (e.g., through heatwaves and flooding). changes in

weather will affect patterns of dengue and other vector-borne diseases, such as malaria, and there will be increases in health risks from water and sanitation problems and non-communicable diseases (e., from air pollution and the heat islands effect), and from risks associated with vector-borne diseases (e., zika) and with food safety (e., pesticide-related issues). climate change will also increase risks associated with malnutrition, mental health, and injuries (e., from floods and drought). (who, 2016) 997 studies have shown that pregnant women have a higher susceptibility to extreme heat than non-pregnant women (ainla et al., 2004). during heatwaves, pregnant women face a higher risk of preterm delivery (sheehan et al., 2005), neonatal deaths (ainla et al., 2004), and cardiopulmonary deaths (ainla et al. preterm delivery and low birth weight are associated with a higher risk of infant death (rabiei et al., 2007). infant mortality is the leading cause of infant death in the united states and in industrialized countries. studies in the united states have shown that a heatwave in july was associated with an increase in infant mortality in the northeast and midwest (su et al., 2010) and that heatwaves were associated with a decrease in birth weight (okely et al., 2015). in addition, heatwaves in the summer are associated with increases in the number of maternal deaths

from hypertension and heart disease (wong et al., 2003). a study in australia found that heatwaves were associated with increases in newborn deaths, particularly among very preterm and low birth weight infants, and that heatwave events were associated with higher mortality rates for both maternal and infant causes of death (dann et al., 2011). however, some studies have shown that heatwaves have no effect on the prevalence of preterm birth (chia et al., 2014), and others have found that heatwaves have no effect on maternal and infant mortality (zhang et al., 2013).
